THREE DIE IN CRASH WEDNESDAY

Father, Mother and Daughter Meet Death Near Burnett After Assisting in Moving From Hustisford.

Death, in all of its shocking gruesomeness struck with the rapidity of lightning Wednesday afternoon and with one bolt, as one would wave a wand, wiped out father, mother and daughter when a Northwestern road train crashed into the truck of Edward Henshaw. Mr. Henshaw, wife and small daughter were upon their way home after having helped his brother, Roy, move his household goods from Hustisford to Mayville.

The small truck in which they were riding was struck by Northwestern Road train No. 28 at the crossing near the Edward Nitschke farm two miles south of Burnett about 4 o'clock.

Death was instantaneous to the father and mother, but persons on the scene within a few minutes after the crash, declared that there was a spark of life in the child, but she died before Dr. H. J. Heath of Juneau, physician, who was called, arrived on the scene.

The body of the father lay about fifty feet from the crossing, while the bodies of the mother and child were about ten feet farther south, the mother apparently having made a desperate effort to protect the child, whose body was partly enfolded in her arms.
